Documents (in original and self-attested copies) required at the time of admission

1.	Filled in admission form (Format available on IEST website)
2.	E-mail received from IEST regarding the physical reporting
3.	The admission cum first-semester fees receipt
4.	Medical fitness certificate (Format available on IEST website)
5.	Class X Admit/Mark-sheets/Certificate (for age proof)
6.	Class XII mark-sheet and certificate
7.	Photo identity card (AADHAAR CARD/VOTER ID/PASSPORT/Driving License etc.)
8.	SC/ST caste certificate (if applicable)
9.	OBC-NCL certificate issued on and after April 01, 2026 (if applicable)
10.	GEN-EWS certificate, issued on and after April 01, 2026 (if applicable)
11.	PwD certificate (if applicable)
12.	Formal affidavit for anti-ragging by the student and parents on ten rupees Nonjudicial stamp paper. (Format available on IEST Website, <u>No need to write student ID; keep it blank</u>)
13.	Blood group report from pathology
14.	Migration certificate/ School leaving certificate/ Transfer certificate

Note:

- 1. All original documents will be checked at the time of admission.**
- 2. All the students must bring the original documents.**
- 3. No original document will be kept by the Institute.**

PHYSICAL REPORTING AT IEST, SHIBPUR

- ❖ The candidates whose seats have been allotted through IAT 2026 and **who has paid the admission cum first-semester fees**, should physically report to the Institute Hall, IEST, Shibpur as per the time schedule (**AUGUST 17 - 20, 2026, 10 AM to 4 PM**).
- ❖ The admission process will be completed after document verification.
- ❖ After verifying the documents, the Verifying Official will generate the Enrollment Certificate

Application for Hostel

- After admission, the students may apply for Hostel to the Chief Warden and hostel may be allotted as per the exiting norms of the Institute. Also, the payment should be made through online using HMC portal. Availability of hostel is not confirmed to all students.
- The hostel application form is available on the Institute website.
- **Mode of Payment for Mess Fees:**
- **Payment of mess fees shall be made only through Debit Card, Credit Card, Net Banking, or UPI. Cash payment is strictly not permitted.**

Attending orientation programme and classes

- ▶ The students should attend the Orientation Programme after the admission.
- ▶ Tentatively, the orientation programme may be held on August 21, 2026.
- ▶ After the orientation programme, the classes will be started tentatively from August 24, 2026
- ▶ Check the Institute website regularly for updates on orientation programmes and classes.
