BS-MS Admission Process through the IISER Aptitude Test (IAT) 2026

Admission to 5-Year BS-MS (Dual Degree)
Applied Geology, Chemistry and Physics

1. Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must be Indian nationals to apply for the BS-MS courses.
- Candidates must have passed the **Qualifying Examination** as stated below:

(a) Class XII (or equivalent) examination either in 2024 or 2025 or 2026 or appearing in 2026 from any board / council recognized by the Council of Boards of School Education (COBSE) in India.

OR

(b) Diploma of at least 3 years duration either in 2024 or 2025 or 2026 or appearing in 2026 from any board / council recognized by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) or COBSE or a State board of technical education.

Candidates who passed the **Qualifying Examination in 2023 or before** are not eligible to apply. Passing year for the Qualifying Examination means the year in which the result of the candidate has been declared as 'pass' for the first time in that particular Qualifying Examination.

➤ Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics as subjects in Class XII are mandatory for admission in all the 5-Year BS-MS (Dual Degree) programs.

➤ Candidates are required to score a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in their Qualifying Examination. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwD are required to score a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in their Qualifying Examination.

The marks scored in the following five subjects will be considered for calculating the aggregate marks criterion:

i. Chemistry

ii. Mathematics

iii. Physics

iv. A language (if the candidate has taken more than one language, then the language with the higher marks will be considered)

v. Any subject other than the above four (the subject with the highest marks will be considered).

- For calculation of the total marks for five subjects, if the marks awarded in a subject is NOT out of 100, then the marks will be scaled (up or down) to 100 so that the total aggregate mark is out of 500.
- If a Board awards only letter grades without providing an equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board specifying the equivalent marks and submit it at the time of online application. In case such a certificate is not provided, the decision taken by IEST, Shibpur will be final.
- For candidates who appeared in the Class XII (or equivalent) Board

examination for the first time in 2025 and reappeared in ALL subjects (for whatsoever reason) in 2026, the best of the two performances will be considered.

- If a Board gives aggregate marks considering both Class XI and Class XII examinations (in the 10+2 system), then only Class XII marks will be considered.
- If a Board gives aggregate marks considering the results of both years of a 2-year Intermediate or equivalent course, then the marks scored only in the final year will be considered. In case such a Board gives marks of both years separately, then also the marks scored only in the final year will be considered.
- If a Board gives aggregate marks considering the results of all three years of a 3-year diploma or courses of equivalent duration, then the marks scored only in the final year will be considered.
- If a Board follows a semester system, then the marks scored in the final two semesters will be considered.
- In case any of the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Language are not evaluated in the final year (e.g., in a 3-year diploma course), then the marks for the same subject from the previous year(s) will be used for calculating percentage of aggregate marks.
- If a Board does not give marks scored in individual subjects but gives only the aggregate marks, then the aggregate marks given by the Board will be considered as such.

2. General Information

- The candidates seeking admission to the 5-Year (BS-MS) Dual Degree programs must apply through the Google form: <https://forms.gle/AWZ4u4Aoj7ve6dM58>
- The ranking of IISER Aptitude Test (IAT) 2026 is the only considered for the admission. The merit list will be prepared solely based on the IAT 2026 rank.
- Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate.
- Candidates must check his/her eligibility before application. Applications not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- The Institute will follow the reservation policies of Govt. of India. Certificate for EWS/OBC(NCL)/SC/ST/Person with Disability (PwD) will be as per Govt. of India Rules.
Note: In absence of any applicant from PwD category, the seat reserved for PwD category will be filled by the candidate(s) who belong to the same category (without PwD).
- **EWS/OBC-NCL certificate should be issued by the Government of India, valid for the financial year 2026-27, and issued on or after April 01, 2026.**
- OBCs should be listed in the current updated central list of OBCs (<https://www.ncbc.nic.in/>). OBCs present in the State list but not covered in

the central list of OBCs are NOT eligible to claim the reservation. The criteria for OBC-NCL will be as per the notification of the Government of India.

- In addition to the distribution of program seats (based on categories of candidates as per Government of India reservation policy) as described above, seats for academic programs offered are distributed into Home State quota and Other States quota.
- “Home State quota (West Bengal)” is ONLY for candidates of West Bengal in which the institute is located.
- “Other States Quota (Other Than West Bengal)” includes all the States and Union Territories EXCEPT West Bengal.
- **Seat Matrix:** The numbers of seats available for the 5-Year (BS-MS) Dual Degree programs for different social, economic and other categories are enumerated in **Annexure I**.
- **Fees:** For detail of fees, please see **Annexure II**.

- **Order of preference for academic programs**

At the time of filling the online application for counselling, a candidate will be shown all the three (03) academic programs. Out of these three (03) academic courses, the candidate is required to choose those academic courses for which the candidate wants to be considered for admission. The candidate is also required to provide their order of preference for these chosen courses. The preference order must be from the most preferred (first preference) to the least preferred (third preference). The preference list must contain at least one academic course. A candidate will be considered ONLY for those courses which are on the candidate’s preference list. Consequently, a candidate will not be considered for admission to an academic course that is not mentioned in the candidate’s preference list.

- After receiving the application, IEST, Shibpur will verify the documents and other information uploaded. At the time of document verification, if any query raised (through email), the candidate must respond within the stipulated time. If a candidate fails to respond to the query(ies) on time, he/she will not be considered for the admission.

3. List of Documents Required for Application

1. Class X Certificate (for Date of Birth)
2. AADHAAR/Voter/PAN card
3. Class XII Mark Sheet and Certificate (Qualifying Examination)
4. IAT 2026 Rank card
5. Valid category certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS), if applicable. **In case of OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2026.**

Please note that

- (i) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL)

category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available on JoSAA 2026 website.

- (ii) ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.
- 6. Certificate for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority.
- 7. Receipt for payment of application fee

4. Seat Allotment Procedure

Seat allotment will be strictly based on valid IAT 2026 rank and the preferences given by the candidate in the order of their merit and priority taken together.

• Preparation of Merit List

A merit list of all the eligible candidates would be prepared on the basis IAT 2026 ranking. Only those candidates, whose application have been received (through the Google form) by IEST, Shibpur, on or before the deadline mentioned in the schedule will be considered for merit list preparation and seat allotment.

• Allotment of Course

Based on the merit list drawn above, the allotment of course would be made as per the preferences indicated by the candidate in his/ her application. A candidate appearing higher on merit list would get higher priority in allotment of course as compared to a candidate appearing lower in the merit list. In case, course of first preference indicated by the candidate is not available, he/ she will be allotted to the 2nd preference (course) and so on. The candidates who have not been allotted any seat in the Round 1, will be eligible for Round 2 of allotment against vacancies (if any).

• Round 1 Seat Allotment

Candidates appearing in the merit list would be considered for the first round of allotment. After successful online verification of the uploaded documents through the Google form, **Round 1** seat allotments shall be displayed on the Institute Website as per the schedule.

No individual allotment letters/ email will be sent to candidates who get a seat allotment.

The candidates are strongly advised to frequently check the web announcements on allotments. IEST, Shibpur would not be responsible for any delay in checking the website by the candidates.

The candidates would be required to submit their confirmation for acceptance of the provisional allotment to the allotted program on or before the deadline specified in the schedule. Candidates, who fail to confirm their acceptance (paying admission cum first semester fees for provisional admission to BS-MS course) within the given time frame, would be presumed to be “withdrawn” and the allotment in the allotted course shall be cancelled. Such candidate will not be considered further for seat allotment in **Round 2**.

Candidates while accepting the seat allotment, if interested, can give their willingness for upgradation (**applicable only for the candidates ALLOTTED Second/Third choice**) of course as per their original choices given at the time of filling the application. If in case no upgradation takes place due to unavailability of vacancies in their higher choices, the previous allotment will be retained in the **Round 2**.

• **Round 2 seat Allotment**

All eligible candidates who were not allotted a seat in the **Round 1** and all those who had opted for upgradation would be considered for seat allotment in the **Round 2** as per the Merit. **Round 2** seat allotments shall be displayed on the Institute website as per schedule. No individual allotment letters/ email will be sent to candidates who get a seat allotment. After payment of admission cum first semester fees for provisional admission to BS-MS course by candidates, the allotment of the **Round 2** will be presumed to be accepted.

• **Reporting to the Institution**

After two rounds of allotment, the selected candidates have to report to the Institutes for admission during the specified dates (as announced in the schedule). All admissions would be subjected to the verification of original certificates/ documents and satisfactory physical fitness as prescribed by the Institutes during the time of admission. Not reporting at the allotted Institute during the specified period may entail the cancellation of the allotted seat.

• Refund policy

The application fee is non-refundable.

For refund of the Admission cum First Semester Fees will be done as per the Institute rule. Candidates must apply in specified format for the refund after the Physical Reporting. No refund is possible before that.

5. Online Application and Admission cum first semester fees

The application fee is to be paid by the candidate during the submission of the application form:

- Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) for candidates applying under General, EWS, and OBC-NCL categories.
- Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred and Fifty only) for candidates applying under persons with disabilities (PwD), and SC/ST category.

Note: The application fee is non-refundable.

Hostel allotment will be done after the Physical Reporting. Hostel Fees to be paid separately after the allotment.
